

Edible 3D Tissue Paper Sunflower



To make your Edible 3D Tissue Paper Sunflower, you'll need:

White Cardstock, Green and Black Construction Paper, Orange and Yellow Tissue Paper, Sunflower Seeds and Glue

Step 1

Cut a circle out of the black construction paper the size of your palm. Place it in the center of the cardstock and trace it. This will help you place your petals.

Step 2

Cut a long stem (rectangle) and leaf shape (pointed oval) out of your green paper. Then glue your green stem and leaf down to your cardstock. It should be in the center beginning from the bottom of the page and into your circle.

Step 3

Cut out as many orange and yellow leaf shapes out of the tissue paper as you'd like. Then glue them down in layers around the circle you drew. There is no wrong or right way, just have fun!

Step 4

When you're satisfied with your petals, glue the black circle on top of the petals where you traced it.

Step 5

Place glue on your black circle and sprinkle your sunflower seeds onto the glue. Let dry.
